- 2 Melamine/Wooden serving spoons

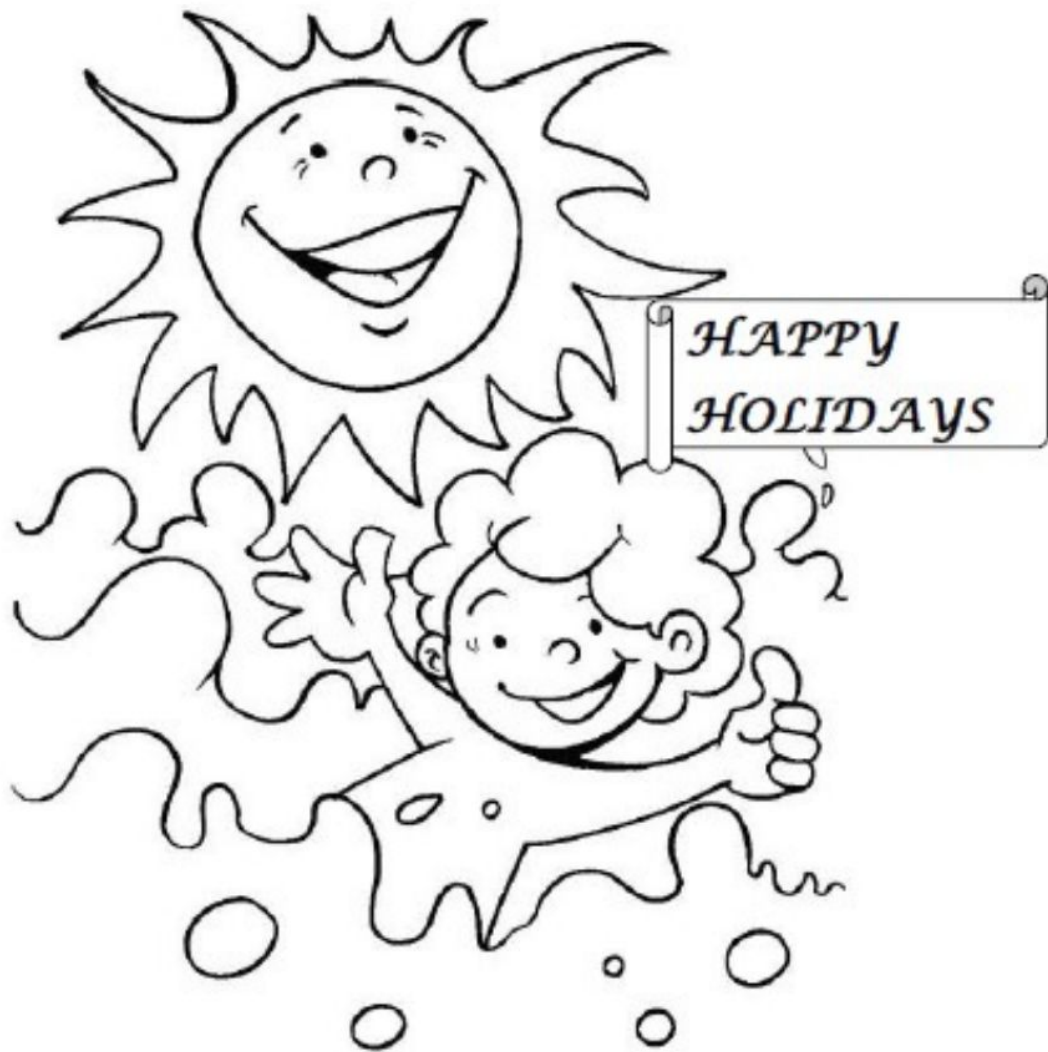
**INSTRUCTIONS:-**

- Make your child learn the story in 5-6 lines by using puppets.



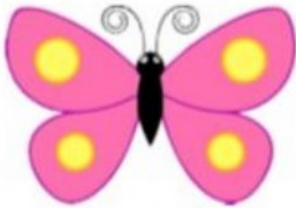
**IMPORTANT:**
